ORDER

This matter came before the Court for jury trial commencing October 18, 2010. On October 21, the Court submitted certain liability and damages issues to the jury, and a monetary verdict was returned in Plaintiff's favor. Before the Court submitted remaining liability issues and punitive damages to the jury, the parties agreed to and announced a settlement. The primary terms of the settlement were placed on the record, and all parties expressed their full appreciation of the consequences of the settlement. The Court is desirous that this matter be finally closed on its docket,

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that this case is hereby DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE as to all parties. If any party fails to comply with the terms of the settlement agreed to in open court, any aggrieved party may reopen the case for enforcement of the settlement agreement. If successful, all additional attorneys' fees and costs from this date—plus appropriate sanctions—shall be awarded to the aggrieved party. The Court specifically retains jurisdiction to enforce the settlement agreement. This settlement agreement constitutes a global release as to all claims and as to all parties with prejudice. This settlement will be finally complete upon execution of release documents.
