FINAL JUDGMENT

This action was tried by a jury with the undersigned presiding, and the jury has rendered a verdict. Pursuant to the Jury's Verdict on December 14, 2010, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED as follows:

1). It is ADJUDGED that Plaintiff, Debbie Brown ("Plaintiff"), failed to prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, that race was a motivating factor in the decision of Defendant, Jackson Municipal Airport Authority ("Defendant"), to not select Plaintiff for the Payroll/Accounts Receivable Accountant position, and the Jury returned a verdict in Defendant's favor. It is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiff's claim of failure to promote under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 is dismissed with prejudice;

2). It is ADJUDGED that Plaintiff failed to state a claim upon which relief may be granted against Defendant under 42 U.S.C. § 1981; therefore, it is ORDERED that Defendant is entitled to a judgment as a matter of law. Plaintiff's claim under 42 U.S.C. § 1981 is dismissed with prejudice;

3). It is ADJUDGED that Plaintiff failed to state a claim upon which punitive damages may be awarded against Defendant; therefore, it is ORDERED that Defendant is entitled to a judgment as a matter of law. Plaintiff's claim for punitive damages is dismissed with prejudice; and

4). It is ADJUDGED that there are no remaining claims against Defendant; therefore, it is ORDERED that this matter is hereby dismissed with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs.
