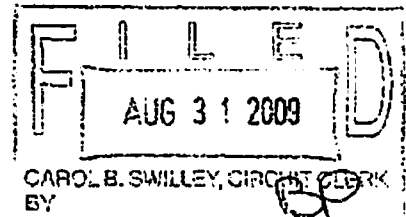



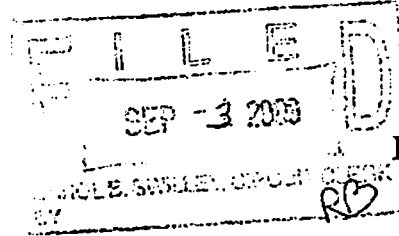

FINAL ORDER DISMISSING ROLLINS LEASING CORP.


