FINAL JUDGMENT AND ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for trial on Monday, February 26, 2018, on the claims of the plaintiffs, Crocker & Associates, Inc., f/k/a D&D Environmental, Inc. ("D&D") and Maxx Investments, LLC ("Maxx") against the defendants J. Dennis Crocker, Gail Crocker, and Crocker, Ltd.; and the respective parties having announced ready for trial and having proceeded with a trial before a duly impaneled jury consisting of twelve (12) good and lawful citizens of Madison County, Mississippi, and the jury having considered the evidence and instructions of law presented to them in the course of trial, deliberated and on Thursday, March 8, 2018 returned a verdict in favor of Defendants J. Dennis Crocker, Gail Crocker, and Crocker, Ltd., which was read in open Court and the jury having been polled and found to have voted ten (10) for the Defendants and two (2) for the Plaintiffs in open court.


IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that, in accordance with the verdict of the jury, the Plaintiffs D&D and Maxx shall recover nothing from the Defendants J. Dennis Crocker, Gail Crocker, and Crocker, Ltd, and the claims of the Plaintiffs D&D and Maxx

against the Defendants, J. Dennis Crocker, Gail Crocker, and Crocker, Ltd, are hereby dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that, by agreement of the parties announced in open court, the Counterclaim of J. Dennis Crocker and Gail Crocker against Marc Daniels to pierce the corporate veil of Maxx is withdrawn and dismissed with prejudice, and Plaintiffs' appeal rights are waived.
